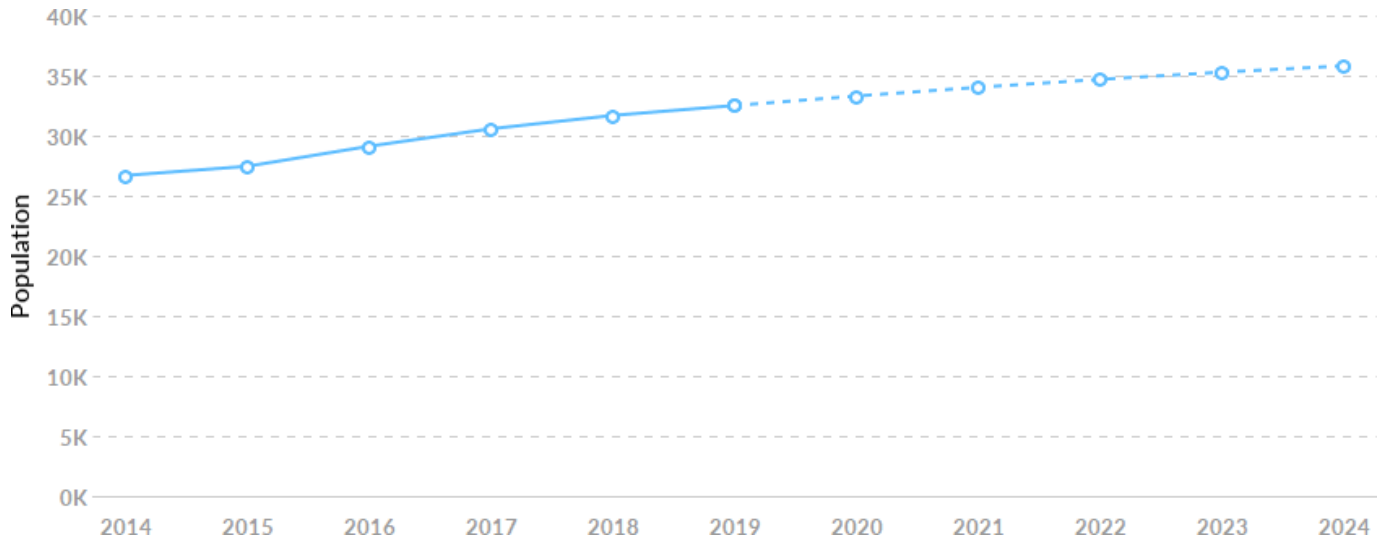

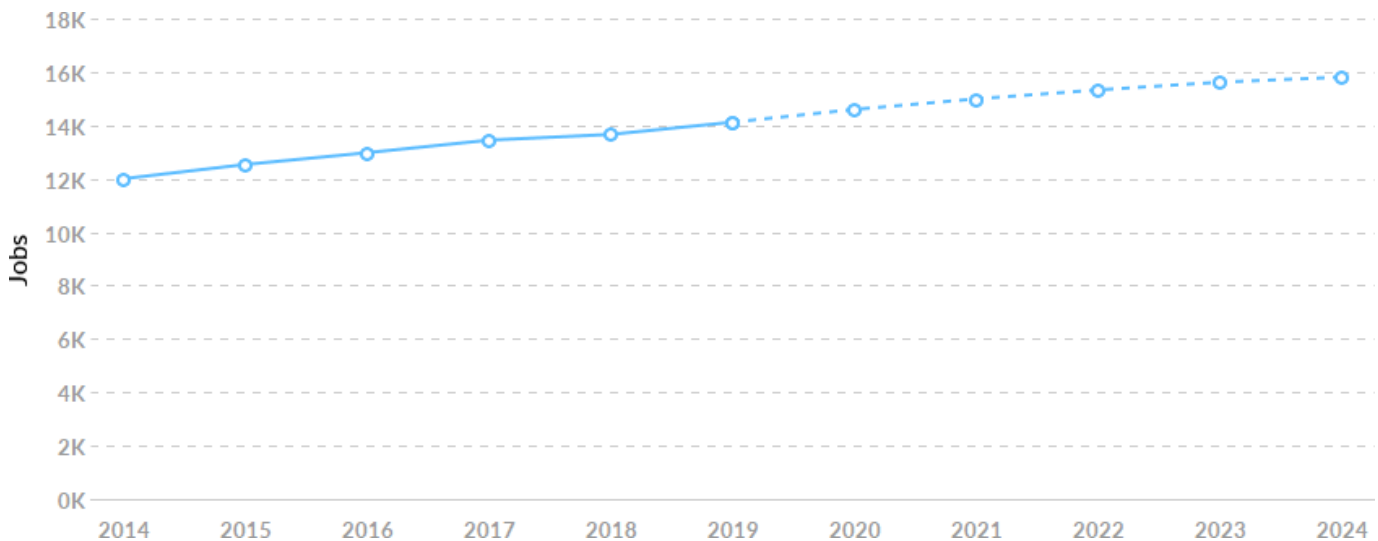

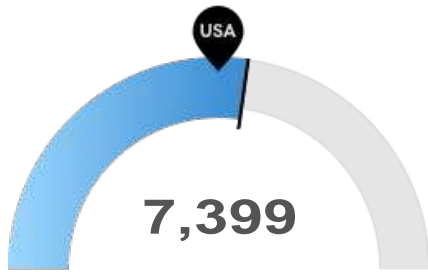
Job Trends

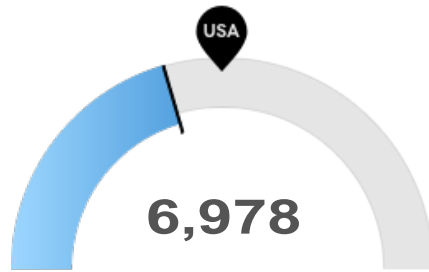

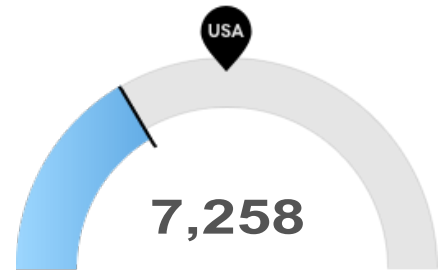
Millennials

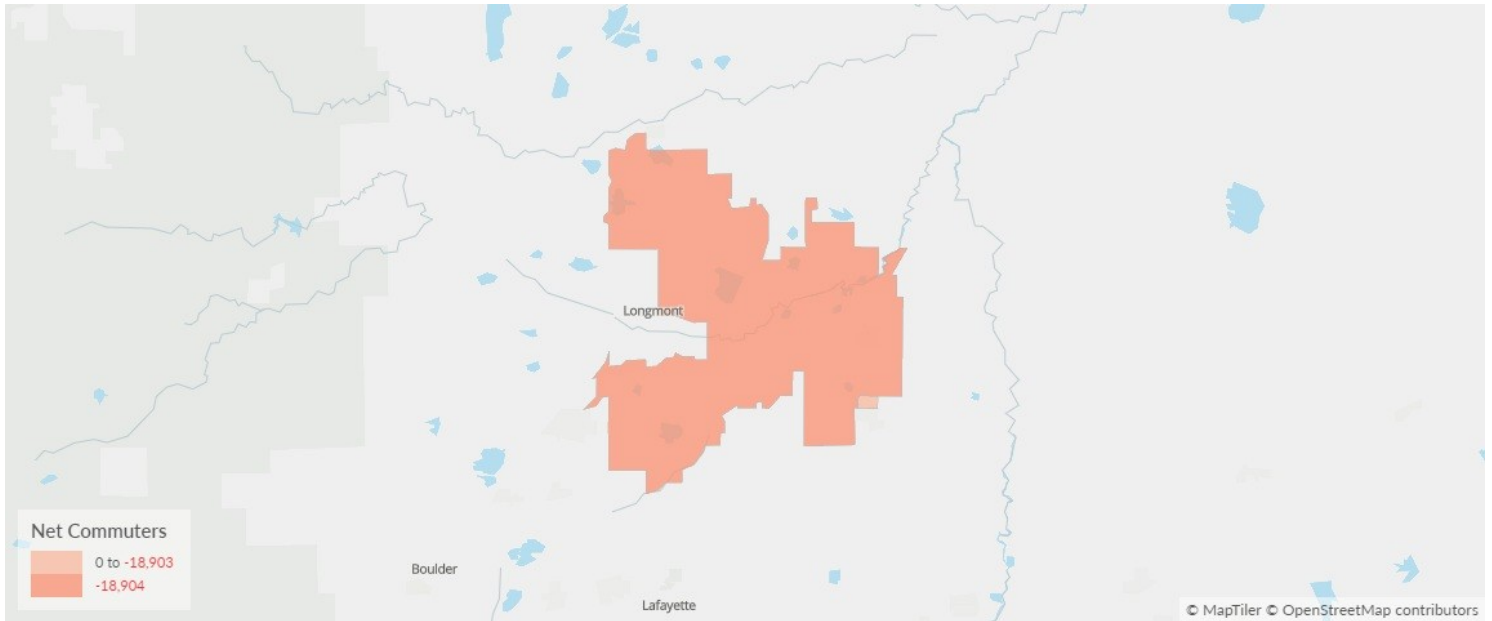

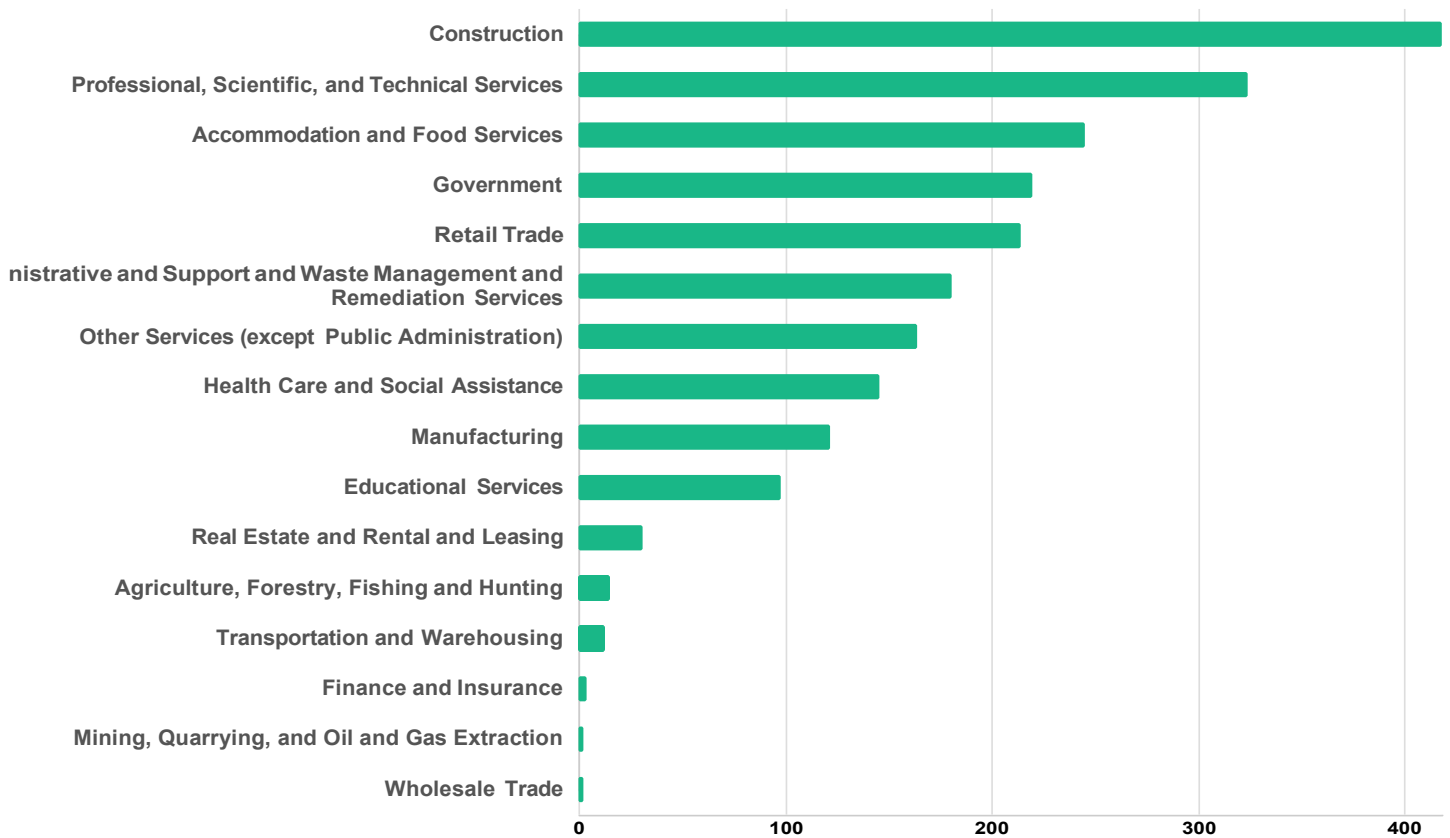

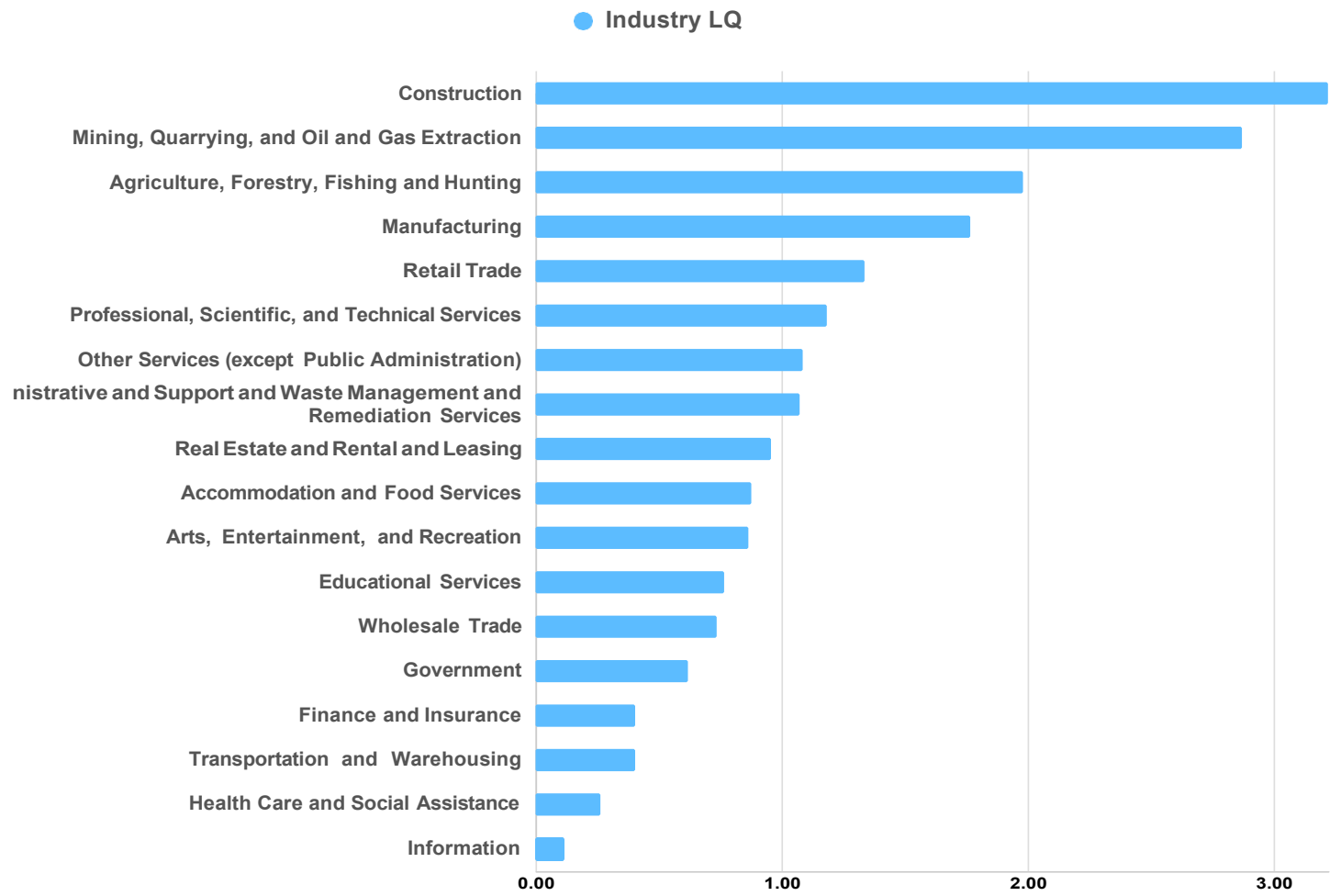

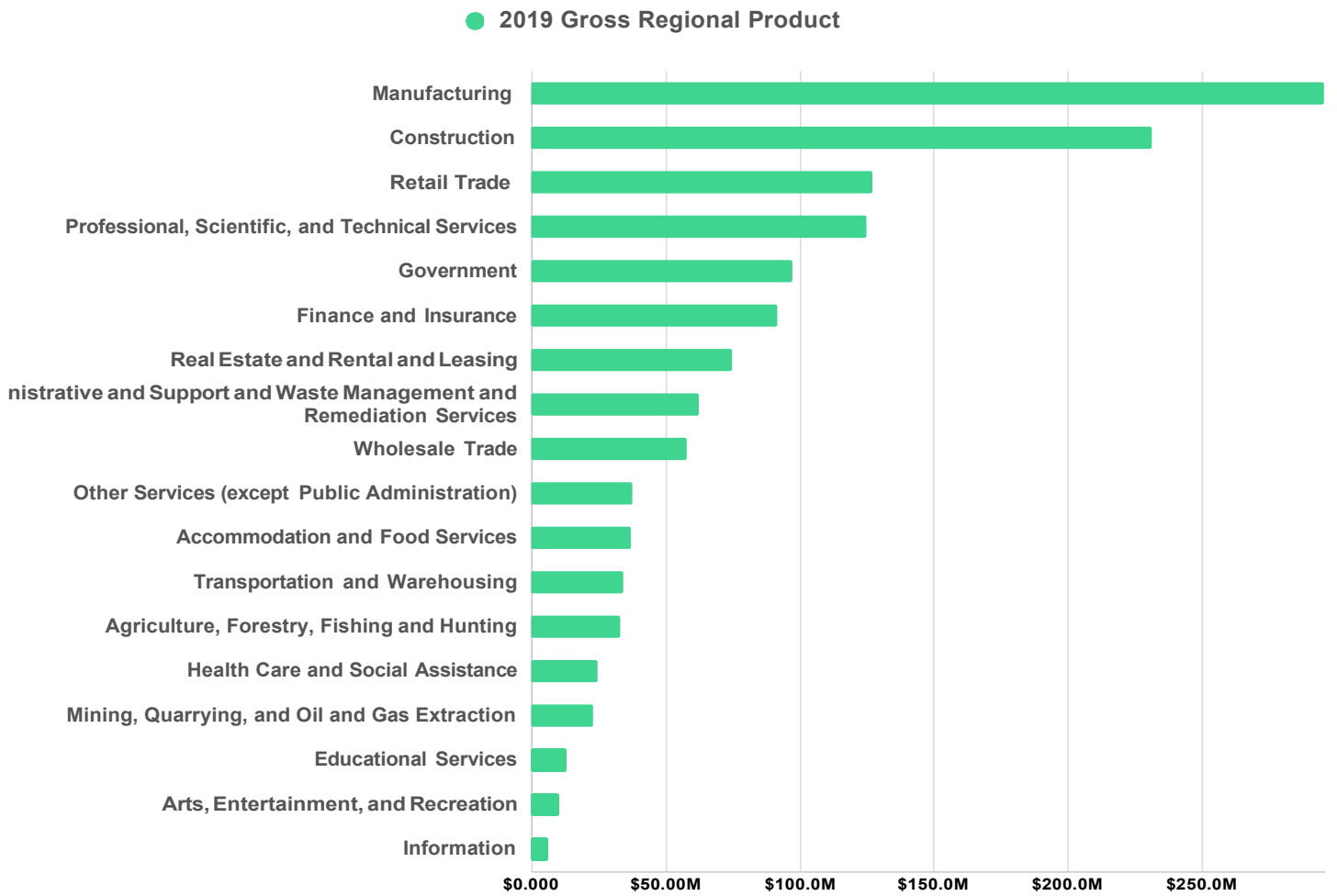

Top Industry LQ

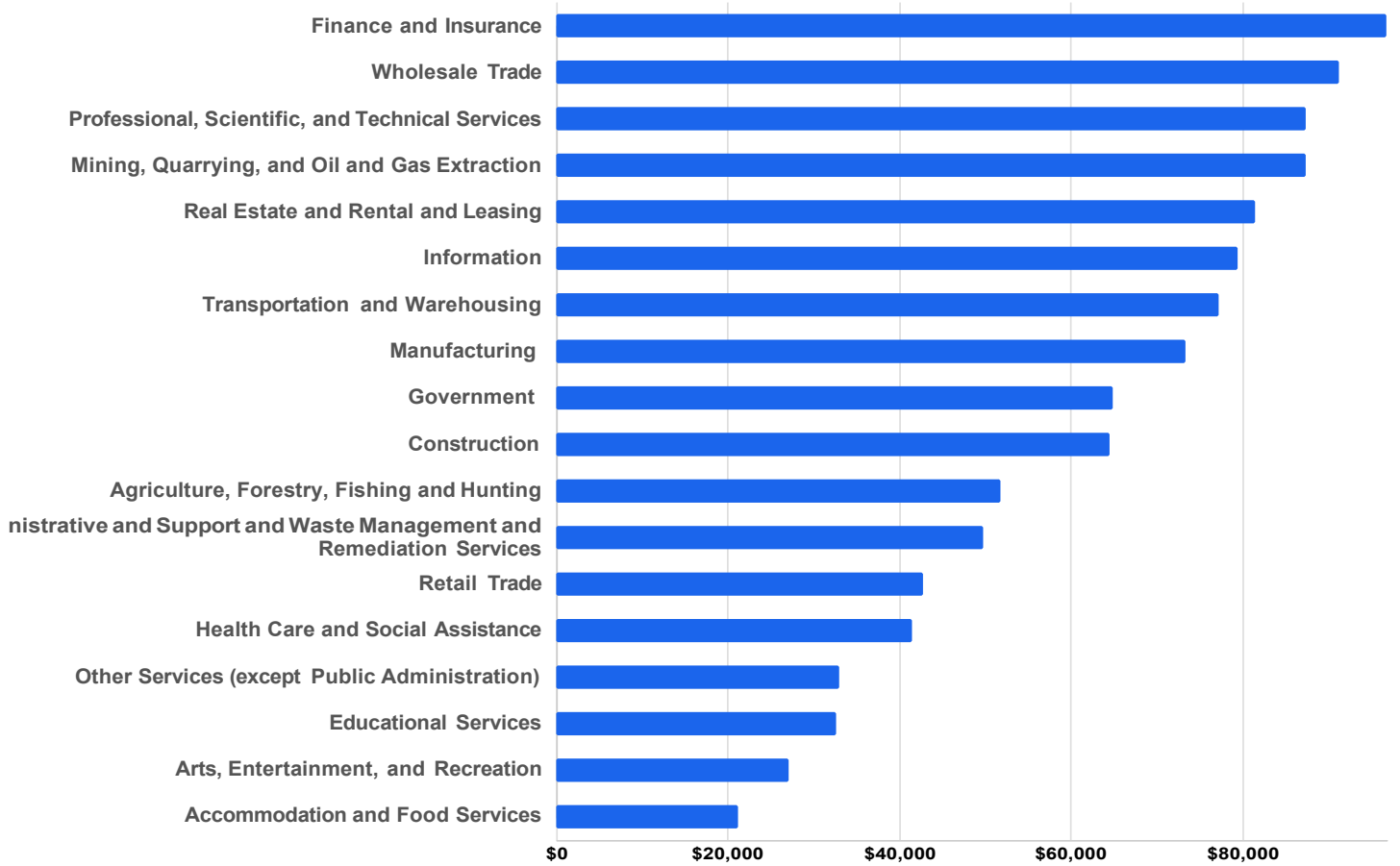


Top Industry GRP

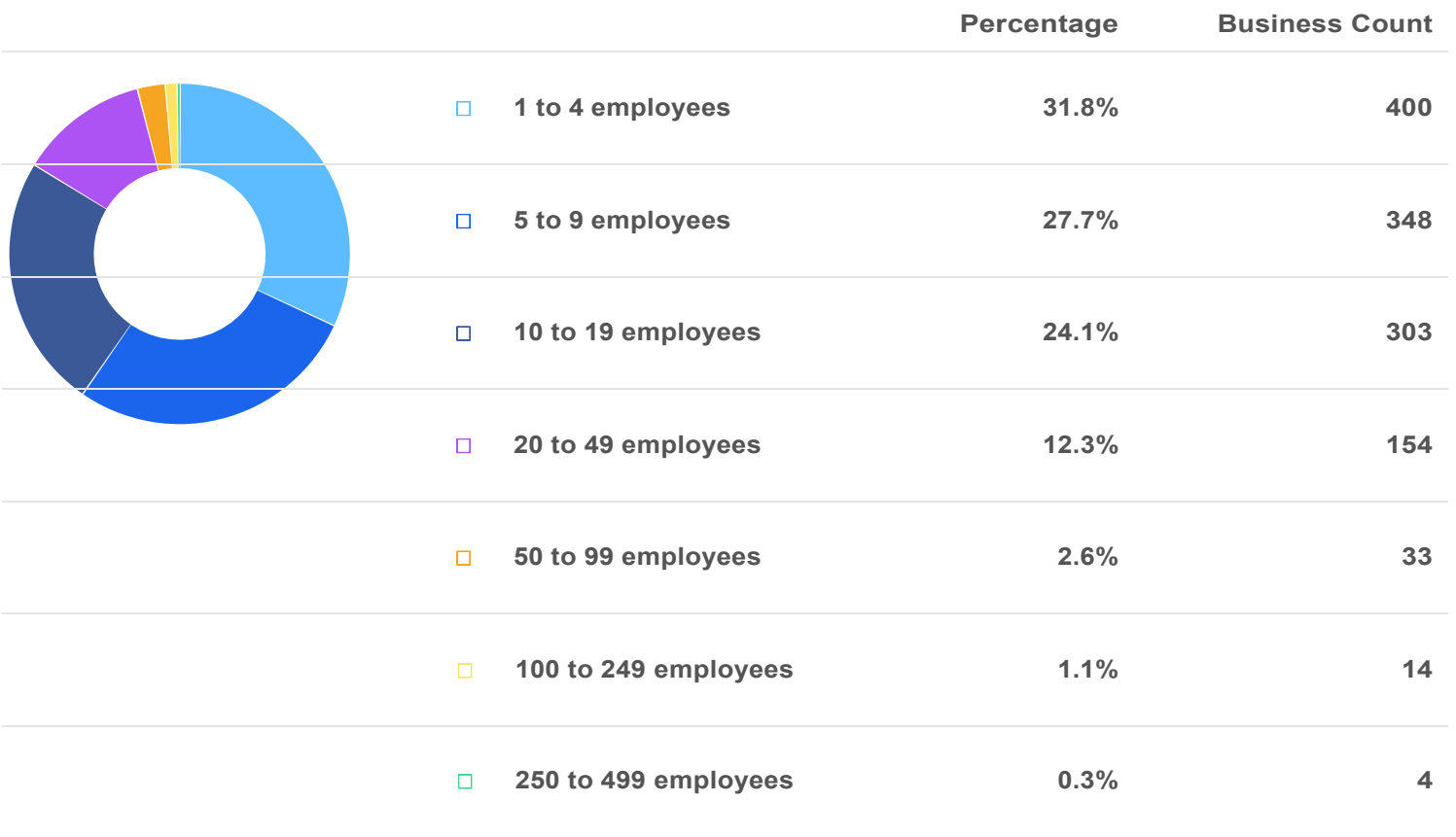

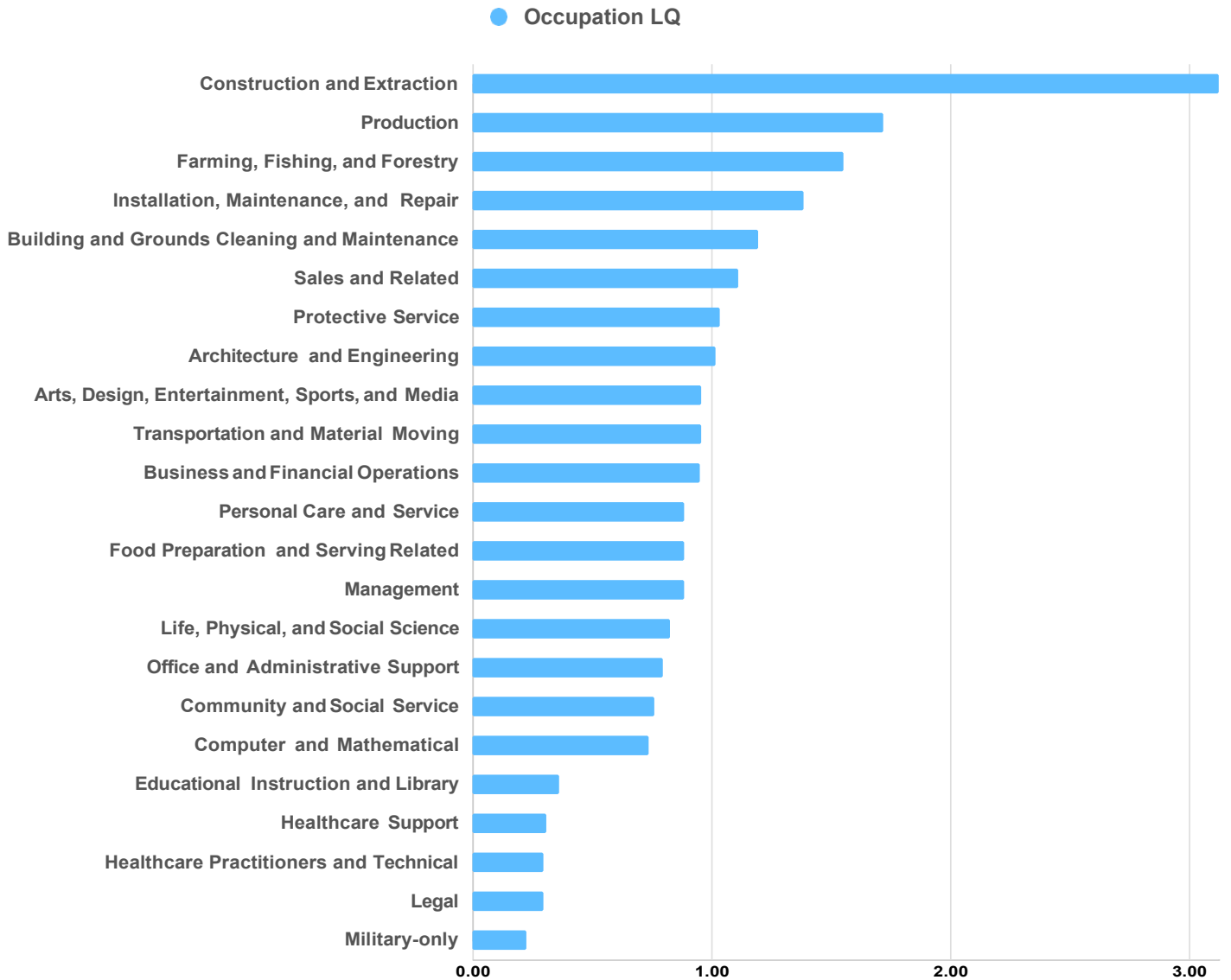

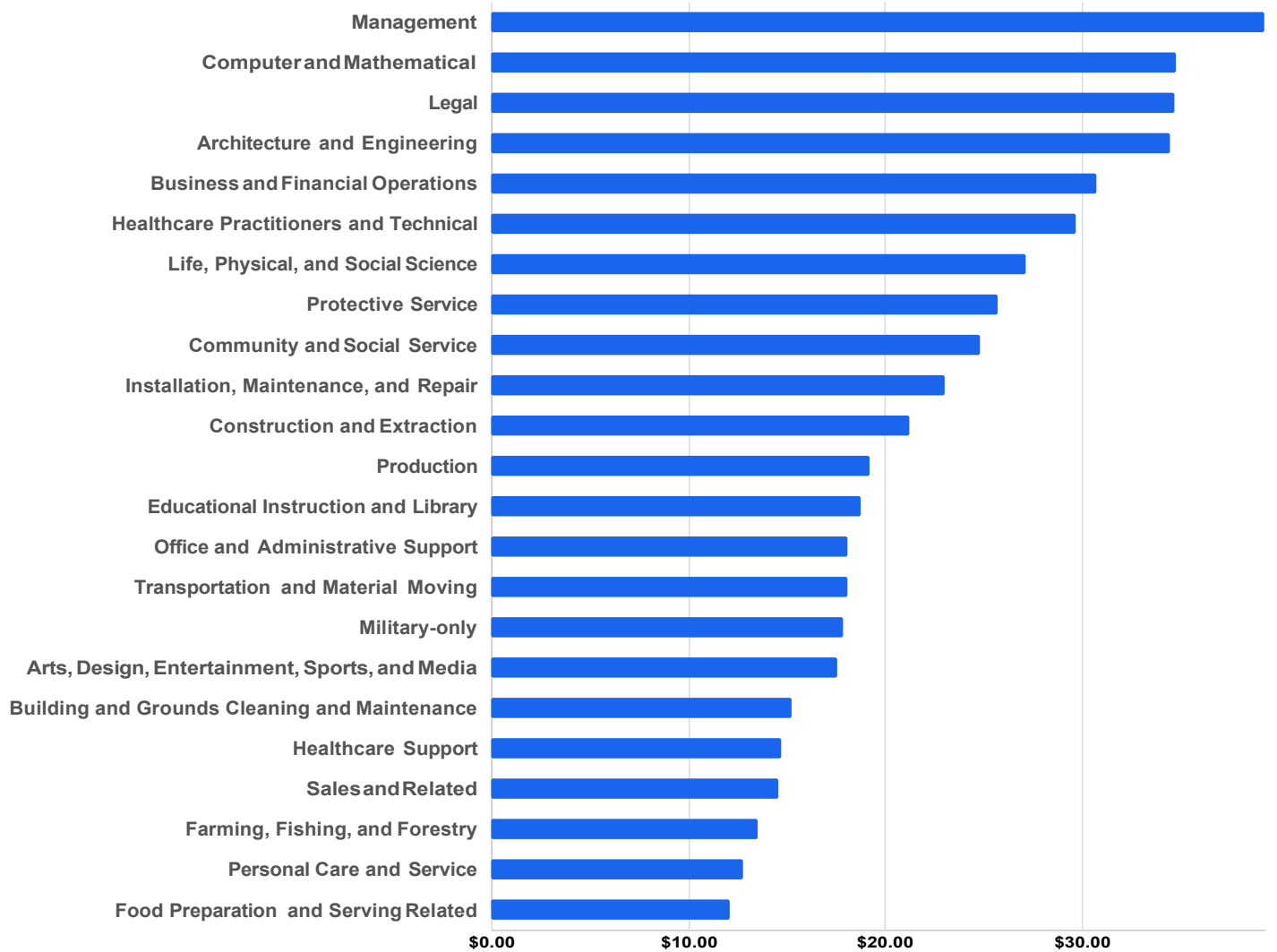
