Denver International Airport (DEN) is the 16th-busiest airport in the world and the fifth-busiest airport in the United States. Six (6) active runways support 1,700 average daily operations, serving 189 domestic and 26 international destinations in 12 countries.

Rocky Mountain Metropolitan Airport (33 miles)

Rocky Mountain Metropolitan Airport (RMMA), a reliever for Denver International Airport, is located just minutes from downtown Denver and Boulder. The Airport is the 4th busiest in Colorado. Northern Colorado Regional Airport (27 miles)

Greeley-Weld County Airport (33 miles)

The Greeley-Weld County Airport is located only 40 miles north of Denver, but outside of the Denver Class B Airspace. It is perfectly positioned to service the needs of all general and business aviation users. The Greeley-Weld County Airport is capable of accepting aircraft in size and weight categories exceeding that published in the Airport Facilities Directory, including certain aircraft in the Airplane Design Group III category with prior approval from airport management.

The City of Longmont, Colorado owns and operates the Vance Brand Airport (LMO). The airport is situated on a 261-acre parcel located 3 miles southwest of the City. The airport has one 4,799 foot runway and is home to 284 aircraft including 4 jets and 4 helicopters.
